To many Christians, much of the Old Testament may seem obscure or irrelevant to life in the 21st Century. However, it is important for us to remember that "All scripture is God-breathed and is useful for teaching, rebuking, correcting, and training in righteousness (II Timothy 3:16)." Thus, the books of the Old Testament contain truths that God intends for everyone, including modern Christians, to apply to our lives. In fact, Old Testament books such as I & II Samuel contain valuable lessons for everyday life because they demonstrate God's people at both their best and their worst – something to which we all can relate.

In our study of I & II Samuel, we are focusing on the events in the nation of Israel at the time of people such as Samuel, King Saul, and King David. As we study the scripture each week, our focus is on the following questions:

- (1) What are God's expectations for His people?
- (2) How does God relate to His people and how do we relate to Him?
- (3) What can we learn from the positive actions of God's people in the Old Testament and how can we apply this to our relationship with Him?
- (4) What can we learn from the negative actions of God's people in the Old Testament and how can we apply this to our relationship with Him?
