Heaven's gates are open wide."


We have a lot of fears. God understands these but fear does not need to control us. We fear:





VIGNETTES by VIRGINIA

HOPE is an activity that needs to be considered. What does it really mean? How does it affect our daily life, and probably important decisions we have to apply?

A brief definition of HOPE is: to desire with an expectation of fulfillment; or to expect with desire; to trust, to have reliance, a longing, dream, wish, yearning or motivation. That sounds like work, or discipline. We are reminded over and over in God's Word of the heavenly Father's love and protection. One of the honorable privileges of the church is the encouragement and fellowship of believers because we hold each other UP through friendship, prayer, worship together, music, Bible study and many other blessings. "We are equipped to carry the Gospel to our individual contexts of friends, family, and coworkers. Obedience to Jesus and His Word must be centered to what we do." (Rick Wood, editor of Mission Frontier).

Some Scripture of encouragement with the message of HOPE follow:

Psalm 42:5, 6 ~ Why are you downcast, O my soul? Why so disturbed within me? Put your hope in God, for I will yet praise him, my Savior and my God. My soul is downcast within me; therefore I will remember you from the land of Jordan, the heights of Hermon from Mount Mizar.

Psalm 62:5 ~ Find rest, O my soul, in God alone; my hope comes from Him.

Psalm 130:7 ~ O Israel, put your hope in the Lord, for with the Lord is unfailing love and with Him is full redemption.

Psalm 147:11 ~ The Lord delights in those who fear Him, who put their hope in His unfailing love.

Romans 5:5 ~ And hope does not disappoint us, because God has poured out His love into our hearts by the Holy Spirit, whom He has given us.

Romans 12:12 ~ Be joyful in hope, patient in affliction, faithful in prayer.

Romans 15:4 ~ For everything that was written in the past was written to teach us, so that endurance and the encouragement of the Scriptures we might have hope.

Colossians 1:27 ~ To them God has chosen to make among the Gentiles the glorious riches of this mystery, which is Christ in you, the hope of glory.

I Thessalonians 5:8 ~ But since we belong to the day, let us be self-controlled, putting on faith and love as a breastplate, and the hope of salvation as a helmet.

Other verses to consider are: Isaiah 40:31 and I Corinthians 13, the 'love' chapter.

God delights in us. It is a privilege to belong to Christ, and especially we know that the Holy Spirit is with us!! **HOPE = LEANING ON JESUS.**
