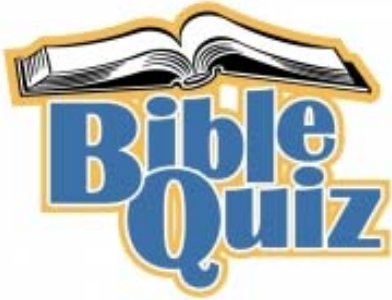

International Bible Quizzing 2018

The CMA held its 2018 International Bible Quizzing tournament at Redeemer University College in Hamilton Ontario July 16 – 20. Twenty teams from the US and Canada joined in the competition. These teams represented 14 different districts. A total of 98 teens participated as quizzers.

Western PA sent two teams to Ontario to compete in the tournament. Norwin Alliance's Emily Cox was team co-captain for Western PA 2. Western PA 1 came in 11th place while Western PA 2 finished in 4th. In addition to the team points, they kept track of individual scores during the preliminary rounds. They awarded the top 15 quizzers with medals at the awards ceremony Friday evening. Western PA boasted three of the top 15 quizzers. One of which was Emily, who came out as the number one quizzer at Internationals this year. Way to go Emily!!

It is amazing to see how well these 98 teens know God's word. To see how much time and dedication they pour into studying the word to prepare for this event is very humbling. Not only do they memorize the Word, but they also learn to apply it to their lives. Seeing the way the quizzers interact with one another all week, how they stand up to defend the other team, and how Christ's light shines through in their lives shows a true understanding of what Paul means when he states in 1 Corinthians 9:25 *"Everyone who competes in the games goes into strict training, they do to get a crown that will not last, but we do it to get a crown that will last forever."* These kids have gone into some very strict training. And while some did earn a medal and recognition that will not last (but is still well deserved), that was not the reason they did it. In the end, they all have earned a crown that will last forever. Having the Word of God in their hearts and minds is a life changing thing. As these kids are preparing themselves to go out into the world, there is nothing more valuable that they can bring along with them than a deep knowledge of God's Word. We hope to see you all on August 24th!

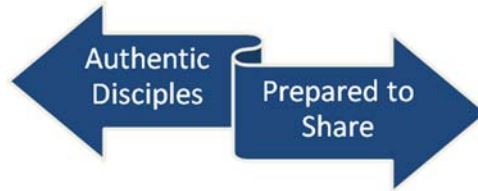

Please:

Pick up a decorative box (available middle of September from table in narthex) and fill it with a variety of gifts and small toys.

Include a check for \$9.00 to help cover cost of shipping

Secure lid with a rubber band

Attach appropriate label (boy/girl) and mark age category

Do Not Include:

Any type of candy; toothpaste; gum; used or damaged items; war-related items such as toy guns, knives, or military figures; chocolate or food; seeds; fruit rolls or other fruit snacks; drink mixes (powdered or liquid); liquids or lotions; medications or vitamins; breakable items such as snow globes or glass containers; aerosol cans.

Can This Go in My Shoebox?:

1. *Are playing cards allowed?* **YES**
2. *Little toys like spiders, bugs, snakes, etc?* **YES**, all these items are allowed.
3. *Batteries?* **YES** - however, if the batteries are loose, both ends must be covered with tape.
4. *Videos, CDs, and DVDs?* **YES** - however, some children may not have a DVD or CD player available.
5. *Paint sets or glue bottles?* **NO** - however, dry paint sets (such as watercolors) or glue sticks are OK to pack.
6. *Toolkit with nails, screws, screwdrivers, and hammers?* **YES** - however, NO saws or pocketknives.
7. *Scissors?* **YES**
8. *Can items with camouflage be included?* If the child can wear or use the items without looking like a soldier, they are OK to include in your shoebox gift. Pink or colored camouflage is safe as are pencils, wallets, or socks.
9. *Glow sticks?* **YES**
10. *Wet Wipes?* **YES**
11. *Rubber balls w/liquid glitter inside?* **NO**
12. *Lip Gloss?* **NO** - however, lip balm or lipstick is OK
13. *Play-Do?* **YES**
14. *Compact mirrors?* **YES** because if the glass shatters, it will be contained.
