Upon the paths of righteousness


Our gracious King



Charles Stanley, pastor in Atlanta, Georgia has written, "Thank God for the blessings that are yours in Jesus". **In Touch**, December 2021.

As the new year will start quickly, it is especially important that our attitudes, routines, desires, relationship, safety, and responsibilities are on the right track - sometimes easier said than done. That is why it is such a privilege and blessing to have God's Word available. Thousands of people around the world must 'hide' the Bible to protect from torture. Often that is hard to believe; but it is, unfortunately, becoming easier to understand even in the U.S.A. Every opportunity, every moment we can stop to PRAY, we need to take advantage and listen to what God needs to tell us.

HOPE is to trust, have reliance, confidence or security. A few verses about HOPE are listed. When the snow does arrive, you can use that time to look into God's Word as you begin a new year—after shoveling the walks. The most important blessing for any time is God's love and redemption. Be thankful. Grab on tightly to His promises. Be ready for Jesus' return. IT MAY BE 2022!! We do not know. Whatever this New Year brings to you, your family, fellow/female workers, children/teenagers, best friends, medical staff, police, pastors/missionaries, government representatives, President Biden/etc, and you can easily add to those names - PRAY, PRAY, PRAY.
