The Outreach Ministry is looking forward to our 2023 Calendar of Events.



VIGNETTES by VIRGINIA

When given a 'call' to missions, the support of believers encourages the person(s) who find his/her home in a distant, foreign country. Most often difficult languages and cultural habits must be learned and accept. When a missionary has the privilege of sharing the Gospel with others who have never heard of Jesus, it is such a joyful time and experience to share salvation and begin a 'church' and Bible study with new believers.

One missionary who serves in Ecuador was interviewed recently when in the States. Most of us know Rachel Wilson, who began 2000 in Paraguay. Four questions were given to her; they will be shared with you now.

1 ~ How did you know that this was the ministry God called you to?

"I believe that the reason that I know this is the ministry God called me to is because I'm doing something I did not believer or could imagine that I would do and that I love it. Also, as I look back, I can see how God was preparing me for this each step of the way. I have joy and I enjoy doing it. I've realized the longer that I'm walking with God that my desires become His desires and so this is what He desires for me. And there are so many times that I realize it's not in my own strength that I'm doing it but it's only through God and the Holy Spirit that I can do what He's called me to do.

2 ~ If you had not become a missionary, what do you imagine you would be doing?

"I really believe that If I had not become a missionary I probably would be teaching in public school, down south in the United States, probably lower income or Title One.

3 ~ What guidance would you give a youth who asked for information about saying 'yes' to Jesus in preparing and studying for missions or Christian ministry?

"I would recommend to them that they don't respond with the question of where but they focus more on the what because you can do most ministries anywhere in the world and there is a great need for people in ministry. I would also say you need to have an obedient heart and your have to be willing to be able to walk by faith and not always understand the why's. Be ready to grow and be flexible. Get involved in some sort of ministry as early on as you can and find a strong Christian to mento you and disciple you. I would also encourage you to memorize Scripture and study the Word of God. You need to be a good student and understand the Word of God in order to explain to others. Learn the different spiritual disciplines and one of those would be learning rest and solitude and what that really means from a Biblical aspect. And my first and final answer would be PRAYER. Invite people around you to be praying for you as you are seeking out what He has for you and as you are growing in your knowledge of the Word and taking on different responsibilities. Prayer is the most important aspect of ministry, yet it is the most overlooked one."
