





Hymn Series III

Lord, Speak to Me

by Frances Ridley Havergal

Even as a young girl, Frances loved hymnology. Her father, Rev. William Henry Havergal, was an Anglican clergyman. His life was devoted to improve the music of the Church of England, writing over 100 hymns.

Frances was born in 1836. By the age of four she was reading and memorizing the Bible. By age seven, she was writing poems. A tragedy hit at age eleven when her mother died. When she needed time alone, her bedroom became a "little Bethel." She found God and was led by the Holy Spirit to assurance of salvation. She was a deeply spiritual writer of hymns and devotional books.

"Lord, Speak to Me" was written in 1872 from the reference of Ephesians 6:20. It was originally entitled 'A Worker's Prayer'.

- 1. "Lord, speak to me, that I may speak In living echoes of Thy tone; As Thou has wrought, so let me seek Thine erring children lost and lone.
- O teach me Lord, that I may teach The precious things Thou dost impart; And wing my words that they may reach The hidden depths of many a heart.
- O fill me with Thy fullness, Lord, Until my very heart o'er flow. In kindling thought and glowing word, Thy love to tell, Thy praise to show.
- O use me Lord, use even me, Just as Thou wilt, and when and where. Until Thy blessed face I see, Thy rest, Thy joy, Thy glory share."
