Everyone respected dad so no one wanted to face his righteous anger and everyone loved when he helped. Isaiah tells us we are to fear our Father in heaven in the same manner. The Lord judges and saves. Jesus speaks these words to Christians today.

Judgments:

“Ah sinful nation, a people loaded with guilt . . . they parade their sin like Sodom. They have forsaken the Lord and turned their back on Him. Even if they offer many prayers, I will not listen . . . What more could have been done for you than I have done? . . . They have no regard for the deeds of the Lord, no respect for the work of His hands . . . Woe to those who call evil good, and good evil . . . Who are wise in their own eyes.” Isaiah chapters 1, 3, 5

Salvation:

“Holy , holy, holy, is the Lord Almighty, . . . the whole earth is filled with His glory. And he will be called Wonderful Counselor, Mighty God, Everlasting Father, Prince of Peace . . . Surely God is my salvation; I will trust and will not be afraid . . . Trust in the Lord forever, for the Lord is the Rock eternal . . . All men are like grass . . . Vignettes by Virginia

Confession: This writer loves to read!! This month's column features a quick summary of a few books that she has read so far this year.

1. God's Smuggler, by Brother Andrew with John and Elizabeth Sherrill, is the story of Brother Andrew's adventures as he and his team traveled undercover into Iron Curtain and other closed countries to deliver Bibles. His work was financed by faith, supported by miracles and filled with danger. The ministry now focuses on the "closed" societies of Islam/Muslim.
2. Women to Women, by Eugenia Price, was written to encourage, and also to admonish women to listen to the teachings of God's Word. It is important to have close "sisters of the faith." Whether married or single, young or old, God has a special place for you to minister to others. "God is a God of wholeness."
3. The Language of Love and Respect, by Dr. Emerson Eggerichs, is an excellent group study book. Written especially for married couples, there are also principles/ideas that can be used in working with children and friendships. Use of Scripture is predominant.
4. Unfinished Believing is Only the Beginning, by Richard Stearns, president of World Vision, is an excellent, thought-provoking book. Mr. Stearns deals with the nitty-gritty, poverty-stricken people in his work/ministry of World Vision. He left a position of CEO of Lenox (china) and follows the prayer of founder of World Vision, Bob Pierce, who said, "Let my heart be broken by the things that break the heart of God." Our marching orders are found in Matthew 28:18-20. "Meaning, purpose and significance are found only by aligning our lives with God's purposes. He chooses us for a mission, and He chooses a mission for us." Dealing with the tragedies of the world and daily life has reminded Mr. Stearns, repeatedly, that his position and ministry at World Vision is not the work that brings purpose to his life. It is Jesus that brings purpose. (John 10:10)
5. The PAPA Prayer. The Prayer You've Never Prayed, by Larry Crabb, introduces us to praying and knowing Christ/God so well that His life actually becomes our life. Praying a "PAPA Prayer" is relational prayer. In understanding this type of prayer, it takes time to change our attitudes and reasons for praying. We should not pray to "manipulate" God, or to become more spiritual. "Bow before God in brokenness, which is the proper position for listening. Develop confidence that every empty space in your soul will be filled and depend on that confidence as your sustaining hope through every trial."
