Amen.






The following were discussed/approved by the Elder/ Ministry Boards at their June meetings:

Interested parties will need to dig the trees/ bushes up.



Titus 2:6; "ENCOURAGE young men to be self-controlled."

Hebrews 3:13 and 10:25; "ENCOURAGE one another daily."
