This book and the Bible give us practical directions for living out the call from Jesus, *"I was sick and you visited Me"*. (Matthew 25:36 NKJV)

Here is Dr. Morgan's teaching from the Bible:

- 1. Everyone's suffering is unique and is really only known to God and that person. (Proverb 14:10)
- God loves the ill person and their illness is not a punishment for specific sin they committed. (John 9:1-3)
- 3. As an infirmed person is visited, this is a reminder of salvation when Jesus came to helpless sinners. (Romans 5:6)
- 4. Your visit to the infirmed person is invaluable because you as a Christian represent the presence of Jesus. (I Corinthians 12:27)
- 5. Food given, a brief visit of 15 minutes, and a prayer offered for the ill person will aid in the recovery and spiritual growth of those in trouble. This alleviates suffering as the Lord shoulders the pain of the troubled. (Isaiah 53:4)

Be faithful in loving the Lord by loving the infirmed.
