In our rebellion we didn’t deserve to be awakened to God or to graduate into knowing His grace. Every influence that worked on us to bring us to Christ was mercy from God.



August 18 ~ YOUTH SUNDAY AND PROMOTION SUNDAY


Our teens will present their program for youth Sunday. Be sure to come and take part in this special service.

All Seniors 50 and up are welcome to join us for Lunch and Entertainment.




"Obedience and Suffering"

It has been said in Hebrews that Jesus learned obedience from the things which He suffered (5:8). It is presumed that He had to grow up and learn how to obey His Father's will even though He was the Son of God already. Obviously, every human being will have to pass through troubled waters from time to time, but Jesus?! He was God but He was man also. He possessed a flesh like you and me. As He grew up, temptation appeared before His consciousness in much the same manner as it comes to you and I. At each episode of evil, He had to make a decision: follow the Father or His flesh (the devil's avenue to wrongdoing). At every turn, deity prevailed! The Holy Spirit in Him gave Him the victory since He was under the divine influence of the Father like no other man. It was at His baptism that He received a greater portion of the Holy Spirit in order to carry out his divine mission.
