

Month of JULY 2021



VIGNETTES by VIRGINIA

The month of June is similar to May also with special days of celebration. June begins on the 4th known as the National Cheese Day, and the National Donut Day ☺

Looking into history, June 14 represents two events that are remembered. The Army Birthday began in 1775 when the first rifle shot was given during the American Revolution. The “Recoats were being fought.”

We are more familiar with Flag Day, the adoption of the American flag by the Continental Congress in the First Flag Resolution, June 14, 1777. The first official recognition was signed into law by President Truman in 1949. (Isn't it an honor and privilege to say the Pledge?)

Hopefully our local veterans have received approval to use the GI Bill that President Roosevelt signed into law June 22, 1944. The title of the Servicemen's Readjustment Act provided a range of benefits of returning WWII vets. Low-cost mortgages, low-interest loans for farms/businesses and education over the years gave the military 'financial assistance' to say thank you for protection and loyalty.

We probably will be kept busy with our gardens, graduations, reunions, weddings, anniversaries, and other daily chores. But let's not forget FATHER'S DAY! What is the true meaning of Father's Day? It is to honor fathers, paternal bonds, plus the influence of fathers in society. Sonora Smart Dodd founded Father's Day in 1910. Actually, Father's Day became a tradition in Monongah, West Virginia as a memorial service for a large group of men who died in a mining accident (1907). Those of us who are BLESSED with our fathers—or a man who may represent fatherhood—it is such a memory as we think of the years we spent together. In a recent magazine, a question was shared with responses from several people. It is a good idea that we also consider this: “It's like I always say QUOTABLE WIT AND WISDOM FROM DADS.” BUT it is more important to depend on Biblical knowledge and teaching we receive from those special guys. Think of verses, songs, 'stories', and especially the
