When we look out the windows during the early months of the new year, we have seen the grass covered with the beauty of white snow. We get exercise shoveling the sidewalks and steps up into our homes. With the excess wind, we need to wear our colorful scarves, gloves, hats with our warm jackets.

Often the weeks go rather quickly; and we think ahead of the spring that will come around before we realize. With this in mind, prepare for the Easter celebration we are honored to observe.

A song that is more familiar to us during the Christmas season has four basic verses. Verses one and two remind us of the birth of baby Jesus. Jesus came to earth as a baby. As a young adult, he began a ministry with a group of men that He was preparing for His death; but He also taught them that He would die for the sins of mankind; the blood that He shed paid the price at Calvary. Jesus also told the disciples hat He was going to live again, and some day return to earth for the believers. Are you anxious to see Jesus come back to earth for the people who have been redeemed?
