When I was younger, I tended to look towards the future. Whether it was the progression of modern convenience or hope for personal achievement, there was at least hope that better days were coming. As I get older, I have found nostalgia for the past a more alluring focus. I suspect that shift will continue as I age, as more of my earthly life will be behind me than ahead. My experience with this future-to-past focus shift is quite typical and is perhaps better understood by those of you who are older than me. Whether your focus is more on the past or future, we all need to spend more time in the present.

Psalm 46:1 says, "God is our refuge and strength, a very present help in trouble." Revelation 1:8 says, "I am the Alpha and the Omega," says the Lord God, "who is and who was and who is to come, the Almighty." Though God exists beyond the bounds of time, we experience Him in the present. The eternal God—who was, and is, and is to come—revealed Himself to Moses, saying, 'I am who I am.'" (Exodus 3:14)

While we can and should reflect on how God has helped us and the ultimate future He will give us, we experience Him in the present. We must not let our nostalgia for the past or hope for our earthly future (before Christ returns) to become an idol that competes with following Christ in the present.

This tension between the past, present, and future isn't new. God's people have always been called to, in one sense, identify as exiles—longing for their true home while remaining faithful in the present. Peter addresses the church in his first letter as exiles. While he was writing in a cultural context that included great persecution of the church, he reminded them that their present situation wasn't their ultimate home.

Yet, living as exiles in the present doesn't mean withdrawing. In Jeremiah 29:4-7 we read, "Thus says the Lord of hosts, the God of Israel, to all the exiles whom I have sent into exile from Jerusalem to Babylon: Build houses and live in them; plant gardens and eat their produce. Take wives and have sons and daughters; take wives for your sons, and give your daughters in marriage, that they may bear sons and daughters; multiply there, and do not decrease. But seek the welfare of the city where I have sent you into exile, and pray to the Lord on its behalf, for in its welfare you will find your welfare."

The people of God are called to live in the present as exiles—exiles called to bless others while awaiting our true home. This call challenges us to know the cultural landscape around us and to seek its good. We were exiles in the past-, and we will be exiles in the future until Christ either calls us home or returns to reign. So let us embrace our calling as exiles—living faithfully as Christ's ambassadors until He calls us home.

INSPIRE students to join the global Alliance family.


