
Each month the preschool children collect specific food items for the Irwin Area Food Pantry.

VIGNETTES by VIRGINIA

May is the month that keeps us busy with a variety of celebrations and holidays. When personally asked, your first response is usually Mother's Day and quickly followed by Memorial Day. Most of the special days during May are a tribute to the military men and women. It is an honor to remember how they serve the United States.

There are four military celebrations during the month of May; let's glance at these day because many of our family members are, or have been, involved in some aspect of service.

- May 8, begun in 1945, known as VE Day and celebrates VICTORY in America and Britain. VE Day is a reminder to rejoice that the Nazis were defeated during WWII.
- Armed Forces Day, the third Saturday of every May, was established by President Truman in 1949 to celebrate all five branches of the US military under the Department of Defense. This is to call attention for any service person in the USA and any foreign country that we should honor and support.
- Cinco de Mayo (May 5), commemorates the Mexican Army's victory over French Empire at the Battle of Puebla May 5, 1862 under the leadership of General Ignacio Zaragoza. There is more popularity and celebration, including parades, dancing, cultural foods and parties in the USA than in Mexico that began in 1863 in California.
- 4. Memorial Day is a definite day; it began in 1868, the last Monday of May as Decoration Day, a Federal holiday, to recognize thousands of US military personnel who died. General James Garfield gave a speech at the Arlington National Cemetery with 5000 participants. Over 20,000 Civil War soldiers are buried there. People began to wear the red poppy as a traditional symbol. It is interesting to remember a Confederate Memorial Day is still celebrated in several states. 3pm is the time on Memorial Day for a National Moment of Remembrance across the USA.

Mother's Day was begun by Anna Jarvis for her mother Ann Reeves Jarvis, a peace activist and caregiver for the wounded soldiers during the Civil War. It took forty+ years to become a "holiday". President Woodrow Wilson signed the proclamation designating Mother's Day for the second Sunday of May as a national holiday in 1914. Today it is one of the most recognized and appreciated acknowledgments presented to the ladies around us—relatives, friends, Christian leaders, daughters, AND of course,

MOTHERS.

Looking at personal calendars, you will probably add graduations, weddings, showers, births, parties? May can be a very busy month and we definitely PRAY that the virus will not bother us like it did last summer. God takes such excellent care of us in His love. Psalm 32:7,8,11: "You are my hiding place; You shall preserve me from trouble; You shall surround me with songs of deliverance. Selah.
