If you are planning to work with youth and children in our church this year, the Western PA District of the Christian & Missionary Alliance requires updated clearances. Your "criminal background check" and "Child Abuse" clearances need updated:

Please do the clearances in this order.

Also, a "Disclosure Statement for Volunteers" is required by the Child Protective Service Law 23 PA. C.S. Section 6344.2 (relating to volunteers having contact with children) must be signed and witnessed.

When you complete the two above clearances, come to the church office and Cindy can witness your signing the Disclosure Statement and copy your clearances.

If you come on a Sunday, Carole Sarber can witness your signing the disclosure and copy your clearances.

The following items were discussed and approved at the Elder and Ministry Board meetings in April:

1. We will resume our Saturate USA project—visiting homes on May 11 at 7pm, May 18 at 7pm, and May 21 at 10:00 am.
2. Travel cost for LIFE has increased. It was approved to ask the youth to contribute towards the trip. Other monies will come from the Special 500 LIFE and Youth funds.
3. It was approved for the Preschool to raise their tuition for the 2022-2023 school year. Registrations are being accepted and classes are filling up. An Open House will be held on Tuesday, July 12th.
4. We fell short of our asking budget for March and our expenses exceeded our receipts.
5. Approved to renew Elk's Maintenance Agreement.
6. Lights around the church continue to be changed over to brighter LED tubes.
7. We are still awaiting quotes from painters for the painting of the church.
8. A Spaghetti Dinner will be held on Sunday, May 1st to help fund LIFE 2022.
9. All those who are/will be working with youth/children at the church need to update their clearances.
10. An in-person VBS will be held 4 consecutive Wednesday evenings: June 22, June 29, July 6, July 13
11. The following outreach events were approved: Petting Zoo on Wednesday, June 1 and July 20 at 6:30 pm; Men's Putt-Putt outing at Kerber's - Saturday, June 25th.

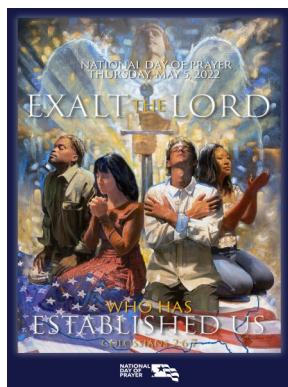
