VIGNETTES BY VIRGINIA

Bright, bold colors of orange, red and yellow on autumn leaves. It is a gorgeous reminder that our weather will soon change from windy, cooler temperatures to days of snow and ice, known as winter. The leaves change colors due to lack of chlorophyll and sunshine to prepare for winter.

We take for granted the four seasons - spring, summer, autumn, and winter - that is caused by the earth on a tilted relative of 23.5 degrees to its orbital plane: that is of the solar system as a flat plate. "Each season differs different weather patterns. The tilt is the main reason we have seasons. Also note the position of the SUN in the sky. In the summertime it will be higher up and rise and set at different positions than it does in the wintertime." (information gathered from Thought.Co).

In God's Word it is interesting to note all seasons are not mentioned; summer and winter are in reference. Genesis 1:14 reminds us of creation and the seasons. When Noah can finally leave the ark he builds an altar to the Lord. Genesis 8:15-22 is a great promise from God of His protection, how the earth will return to winter and summer. Psalm 74:17 has a similar promise.

Psalm 104:19 uses the words *seasons, the sun and moon.* All need to work together.

I Thessalonians 5:1 is Paul writing to the brethren concerning the times and *seasons*.

As we glance out the windows to enjoy the beautiful colors, we know people travel to view the glamour of autumn. Wonder if they realize it is part of creation and God's gift to us?! The Biblical reminders of our temporary place of life, despite the hardships, we can be assured that God knows what is happening by just looking at red, orange and yellow leaves and know there is a reason of four seasons. The most important is the gift of salvation. No matter where we live, how many years we are on earth, out final destiny is dependent on our relationship to Jesus Christ.

Will close with verses from missionary friends, the Campbells - Ezekiel 36:26,27. "Moreover, I will give you a new heart and put a new spirit within you; and I will remove the heart of stone from your flesh and give you a heart of flesh. And I will put My Spirit within you and cause you to walk in My statues, and you will be careful to observe My ordinances." (read it in the Message Bible also)
