

The boxes from the Mid-Atlantic Region (PA and New Jersey) went to the Ukraine. They confirmed distribution prior to the war. 610,234 boxes! 12,473 boxes just from Westmoreland County plus 191 "Build a Box" which is online.

Associate Pastor, Billy Barnes of Covenant Presbyterian Church in Nashville, Tennessee has shared this message that "the love of God is not meant to make us a storehouse but a distribution center." God has poured His love into our hearts so that we will resonate like instruments of praise (Romans 5:5). God resounds His purposes. We have been shaped with great intentions, made to one day resonate His glory in perfect wholeness (Hebrews 12:12, 13).

The grain of truth grows slowly. There is a grain written in our design, and we have a skillful designer who first made us and is now forming us into who we are meant to be.
