My daily routine has changed, somewhat, to say the least. I still take care of laundry, housework, cleaning up after our dog Biscuit (who is an answer to prayer after brain surgery and needing a 'therapy pet'), meal prep, and basic chores. Miss the privilege of driving, hope to get that back. Try to spend more time in God's Word and talking to Him in prayer. I am very aware of the blessed benefit of being a believer and knowing even though our world is in a horrible mess, God is in control; He loves us so very, very much. AND He will be sending His Son Jesus back to earth to get the Christians. We need to be ready NOW!

I want to thank you so much #1 for your prayers. #2 for cards. I miss coming to church; playing the organ. Most Sundays I watch the service on the computer. #### **Book of Genesis**
